

The **2011 UANA Cup for Men** commenced on Sunday, January 9 in Victoria, Canada. On the day before the competition, the Technical Meeting was held. Three (3) countries were present at the Technical Meeting – Argentina, Brasil and Canada. Cuba had withdrawn for economical reasons. The United States of America had previously qualified and did not enter. Two (2) teams from this event will qualify for the 2011 FINA World Aquatic Championships in Shanghai, China in July.

The four (4) referees present were: Diego Garibaldi (ARG), Jose Werner (BRA), Mikhail Dykman (CAN) and Mark Koganov (AZE). Lynn Wittstock (USA) and Neil Muir (CAN) were present as members of the UANA Technical Water Polo Committee. William Shaw (CAN) was present as UANA Executive Committee Water Polo Liaison.

After Cuba cancelled its participation, the format was revised to be a 3 team round with a final and semi-final. The draw for the competition was done at the FINA Bureau meeting in Dubai (December, 2010) with representatives from the participating countries present.

Argentina played Brasil in Game #1 on Sunday. ARG took a 4-2 lead after the first period, but visibly tired, and with shaky goaltending, BRA took control in the 2nd period and won the first game of the tournament by a score of 13-8. Multiple goal scorers were Emilio Vigira and Ruda Franco with 3 each for BRA and Jonas Crivella adding a pair. For ARG, each of Gonzalo Echinique and Andres Maroni helped their cause with a pair.

In Monday's Game #2, ARG played the host country, CAN. After taking a 2-0 1st period lead, CAN won each of the next 2 periods by 4-1 scores cruising to a 13-4 victory, never really being threatened by the ARG team, which had problems creating scoring chances. CAN's multiple goal scorers were Nicholas Constantin – Bicari with 4, Omar Touni with 3 and Constantin Kudaba and Devon Diggle adding a pair each while each of Gonzalo Echinique and Ivan Carabentes scored twice for all of the Argentinean goals.

On Tuesday, Game #3 saw BRA play its rivals from CAN. BRA took 1-0 and 2-1 leads in the 1st period, but CAN led 3-2 at the end of the period. CAN extended its lead to 8:4 and 11:6 at the end of periods 2 and 3, finally winning the game by a score of 15-9. Nicholas Constantin –Bicari led the Canadian goal scorers with 5 goals, Oliver Vikalo and Devon Diggle notched 3 each while Aaron Feltham added 2. For BRA, Bernardo Rocha and Ruda Franco each scored twice .

Game #4 saw the second and third placed teams, BRA and ARG, play an elimination game. The winner would face CAN in Thursday's final game, but more importantly for the teams in the water, the winner would also qualify to attend the World Championships in Shanghai, China in July. As in their first encounter of the tournament, ARG grabbed an early lead after the end of the first period, taking a 3-1 lead on the basis of goals from Testa, Maroni and Montane while Crivella picked up the single counter for BRA. With both teams playing a fairly even and controlled game, BRA tied the game at half-time taking the period 3-1 so that the score was tied at 4 at half time. Silva, Crivella with his second and Nolasco scored the BRA counters while Maroni added his second for ARG . The second half saw good defensive play and stellar goaltending from both teams. Silva scored for BRA within the last minute of the period to give BRA a 5 -4 lead heading into the 4th period. After a minute and a half of play in the final quarter, Echinique tied the game at 5-5 for ARG. At 5:32, Felipe Silva scored to give BRA a one goal lead 6-5. Despite having chances to tie the score, strong BRA defence and goaltending denied ARG any further goals and the game ended with BRA taking a hard fought 6-5 victory. BRA qualified for the World Championships, reversed the 1 goal defeat that ARG had inflicted on them at the last South American Championships and gained the opportunity to play CAN for the gold medal in Game #5.

The Gold Medal game, Game #5, was played between CAN and BRA in front of a capacity crowd at the Victoria Commonwealth Games Pool on Thursday night. CAN took the first lead of the game on a goal by Constantin –Bicari but BRA, on goals by Nolasco, Henrique Miranda and Crivella quietened the crowd and took a 3-1 lead at the end of the first period. BRA extended their lead to 4 -1 early in the 2nd period on a goal by Vigira, prompting Dragan Jovanovic, the CAN coach , to

change goaltenders in an attempt to enervate his team. The tactic appeared to be successful as CAN scored the next 5 goals (Graham with Touni and McElroy netting a pair each) to put CAN into a 6-4 lead. Before the period ended, Coelho scored for BRA and it was matched by a goal for CAN from Graham so that the half ended with CAN leading 7-5. Graham scored early in the 3rd period to give CAN apparent control of the game at 8-5 but BRA scored twice (Henrique Miranda and Correa) to bring the Brazilians within 1 before Feltham gave CAN a 8 -6 lead at the end of the 3rd quarter. The final quarter saw BRA tie the game with 2 unanswered scores – the goals coming from Coelho and Franco – as strong BRA defence and poor CAN shooting saw the hosts shut out for a full period – the first time this had happened to them all period.

The game then went into the 2 three (3) minute overtime periods prescribed by the rules. CAN, bolstered by the full capacity home crowd, scored 4 times in the 2 periods (Constantin –Bicari, Graham, Kudaba and Conway) while Coelho countered with the sole BRA goal. CAN won the match, 13 -10, and secured the top seeded of the two (2) spots reserved for the Americas at the 2011 World Championships.

The formal medal and cup presentation followed the game and another successful UANA Water Polo Event was concluded.
