Championship Event

On behalf of _____ (Federation), we herewith submit a bid to host and conduct the 2006 ASUA/UANA Pan American Junior Swimming Championships (the "Championships"). The preferred time line for running this Championship is late June or July 2006. This competition will be open to Males borne 1989, 1990, 1991 & 1992 and Females borne 1990, 1991, 1992 & 1993.

If our bid to host the Championships is accepted, we agree to comply with all applicable 2006 FINA Swimming rules and regulations and to meet the ASUA/UANA requirements for hosting the event.

ASUA/UANA Requirements:

1. Requested information must be provided, including the three (3) attachments listed below.
2. A bid fee of \$1,000 (US) must be provided with the bid. If the bid is successful, it will be retained by ASUA/UANA to ensure the success of the event and, if the bid is unsuccessful, it will be returned without deduction. Following successful completion of the Championships, ASUA/UANA will return the bid fee to the Federation.
3. A fixed daily cost of room and food must be provided for the participants. If possible, the official hotel should be named.
4. Local transportation must be provided for the participants and officials.
5. Air transportation, housing, food and local transportation must be provided for the ASUA/UANA technical delegate to be appointed by the ASUA/UANA Executive Committee.
6. Housing, food and local transportation must be provided for the eight (8) members of the ASUA UANA Technical Swimming Committee.
7. Appropriate medals must be supplied for the top 3 places in each event plus high point award for a male and a female from each ASUA/UANA Zone.
8. Liability Insurance must be provided covering the event and participants
