

UANA Masters Technical Committee Report
June 8, 2009

On May 7-8, 2009, the UANA Executive Committee met in Ft Lauderdale. Prior to the UANA Executive Committee Meeting our UANA Masters Technical Committee had several concerns in order for us to function well as a committee. We were lacking 2 Committee Members from South America, an Athlete Representative, and getting the necessary information to all federations for the 3rd UANA Pan American Masters Championships in Mexico.

At the UANA Executive Committee meeting we submitted the name of David Morrill to the UANA Executive Committee for approval as the UANA Masters Technical Committee Athlete Representative. I am pleased to announce, David was accepted by the committee and will be a full functioning member. David will be very beneficial in securing a bid for the 4th UANA Pan American Masters Championships in 2011. He will report to us as he has information. Please welcome David to the Committee he will be a valuable asset.

With regard to the 3rd UANA Pan American Masters scheduled for Mexico in October 2009. The UANA Masters Technical Committee has been assured by the new Mexican Federation President, Kiril Todorov, that the 3rd UANA Pan American Masters Swimming Championships will be held in Veracruz, Mexico, October 29 - November 1, 2009. An Event Director, Juan Jose Palacios has been appointed and will be working with the committee. Information regarding these championships will be posted shortly.

The UANA Masters Technical Committee has been functioning without two committee members from South America. In discussions with Luis Pérez, our UANA Executive Committee Liaison about this problem, he indicated he would contact the president of CONSNAT and submit two names or have the committee submit names so our committee will be complete.
